Job Statement

The CREW HELPER position requires handling of the layout and pickup of the geophones and is a front line position. The CREW HELPER position reports to the Crew Leader, Coordinator and CrewManager.

Essential Functions

- Required to attend all crew safety orientations and hazards meetings that pertain to the job.
- Assigned daily duties by the crew Coordinator and/or game plan.
- Required to proceed to the field in a designated vehicle while following ALL safety policies.
- Required to position geophones in the assigned location with the proper spacing as outlined by coordinator
- May be required to deploy/carry/retrieve recording equipment
- Other tasks may be required depending on job terrain.
- Ability to work extended hours per day in remote conditions
- Ability to walk long distances in varying terrain
- Ability to lift and carry 50-60 pounds multiple times daily
- Ability to work in all types of weather conditions

CREW HELPER is responsible to comply with all safety policies, procedures and Personal Protective Equipment requirements at all times. Driving, weather, wildlife and terrain all have the potential to be high risk hazards and need to be addressed based on company guidelines.
