BUSHE RIVER AND MEANDER RIVER MEMBERS & RESIDENTS**

PUBLIC NOTICE – SEPTEMBER 11, 2020

Dene Tha' First Nation and Indigenous Services Canada are going together as a team to each household to offer COVID-19 testing to all people living in the community of Bushe River and Meander River. You will see one DTFN Community Health Representative (CHR) and a couple of Indigenous Services Canada nurses come to your house. The Community Health Representative will come knock on your door; please answer and let us know if you would like to have the testing done in your household.

The following dates are scheduled for testing for Bushe River and Meander River:

Drive-thru Testing for Bushe River

September 12, 2020 outside the Four Chiefs Complex from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

Drive-thru testing for Meander River

September 13, 2020 outside the Health Centre from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

Door to door testing for Bushe River

Scheduled for **September 14, 15 and 16, 2020.**

Door to door testing for Meander River

Scheduled for **September 17 and 18, 2020.**

COVID-18 testing in Chateh is available at the Chateh Health Centre Monday – Friday, please call 780.321.3971 to book appointment.

- Why get tested? Someone can have no symptoms and feel fine but still test positive for COVID-19. This means that they could potentially pass COVID-19 on to others without knowing it. Getting tested will help to protect your community and those you care about.
- Even if you have been tested before, you could have been exposed in the meantime so it is important to be tested again.
